



OASIS VI FLOAT PLAN



The Skipper must complete Sections 1-5 of this report and submit it to the Commodore for approval **at least 30 days prior to departure.**

OASIS VI must carry no less than three nor more than six persons, two of whom must be qualified Skippers. The total trip may not exceed four consecutive days.

The Skipper must notify the Commodore (or designate) upon the safe return to the Marina.

In the absence of a timely Safe Arrival call the USCG might be notified.

If the return is delayed the Skipper must inform the Commodore (or the officer holding the float plan).

This will avoid unnecessary searches.
