

# The EVA Challenge



This is a standing challenge to all OSC sailors to set a round-trip sailing record.

The EVA oil platform is at 33° 39.864'N 118°02.969'W.

When you sail from Newport Beach to Long Beach you usually pass between the oil platforms Emmy and Eva. EVA will be on your port.

## The Challenge

Start sailing by crossing a line between the Newport Harbor buoy and the end of the West jetty. Sail to EVA, round it (in the direction of your choice) and return to the starting line. No engine. The round trip is about 21 nm.

If you think that you and your crew set a noteworthy time please report the details to the Commodore so it can be recorded and posted.
